

12. At approximately 12:05 p.m., I began to inventory the smaller of the two boxes. The box, which was labeled "Savin - 2100 Copier Paper," was closed but not sealed.

13. At approximately 12:15 p.m., I discovered an unsealed brown paper bag inside of this box. The paper bag had the words "Slides, Hair, Sperm, Pub. Hairs" written on the outside. Inside the paper bag, I found the following items:

- a) Two cardboard packages wrapped in brown napkins that were taped closed, one of which appeared to contain two slides, and the other of which appeared to contain three slides;
- b) One cardboard package that was labeled "Plante, Lenice 7/13/83 - 6A 2 air-dried slides";
- c) One cardboard package that was labeled "Plante, Lenice 7/13/83 - 6A 2 air-dried slides Inez Jones";
